

FINANCIAL AID

Saint Joseph School is the grateful recipient of limited tuition assistance grants from the Catholic Schools Foundation. The Catholic Schools Foundation (CSF) is the premier non-profit institution for granting aid to low-income students to attend Catholic elementary and high school in the Archdiocese of Boston. CSF changes lives by providing families with demonstrated financial need an opportunity to give their sons and daughters a quality education, focused on Christian values and character formation at Catholic Schools located throughout the Archdiocese of Boston, regardless of race, religion, ethnicity or gender.

Application Process:

Families requesting financial aid for the 2024-2025 school year must complete an application through FACTS, our tuition management system. There is an application fee of \$40 per family. The application form can be found online at https://online.factsmgt.com/aid.

Please note: Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered.

Filing Deadlines:

- Enrolled Families must file by April 1, 2024
- New Families must file by September 1, 2024

The application must include the most current Forms 1040 and W-2. Families must reapply for financial aid within the FACTS Grant & Aid system each year.

Eligibility criteria:

Financial aid is allocated based on financial need determined by the calculations on the FACTS Grant & Aid application, an objective and independent third party.

Scholarship support is for students in **kindergarten through grade 8** at Saint Joseph School. Preschool students **are not** eligible for financial aid.

Notification of award: Immediately upon receipt of notice of award by the Catholic Schools Foundation.

Financial aid will not be awarded or may be lost if any of the following occur:

- Withdrawal from the school
- Not active in the FACTS Payment Plan
- Accounts are not current, including, but not limited to tuition, after-school or other fees.

Due to the limited amount of grant funding available, we may not be able to provide tuition assistance for all the families that qualify. We make our best effort to help as many families as possible to afford a Catholic education for their children.
