



## SAINT JOSEPH SCHOOL SUMMER PROGRAM

The summer program at Saint Joseph School is designed to provide children with an experience that is both fun and educational. It is offered to parents seeking structure and supervision for their children during the summer vacation months, and it is open to all children from preschool through grade 4.

### **Important notes:**

- The program will run from Monday, June 23th through Friday, August 8th from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.
- The program will be closed on July 3rd and 4th for the Independence Day holiday
- Children must be dropped off by 8:00 am. Since this program offers structured, educational fun and is not daycare, it is important that your child arrives promptly in order to not interrupt the programming that is session for a given day.
- Children must be picked up by 2:00 pm daily. There is an additional charge assessed for children who are picked up late. The Extended Day Program will run from 2:00pm-4:30 pm. (Unless children are attending extended day, then late fees would be charged only after 4:30 pm.)
- Parents are responsible for providing one (1) daily snack, lunch and drinks.
- Since morning activities often include playing in the sprinklers on warm days, please send your child to school wearing a tank top/shorts.

The summer program will consist of weekly sessions, and each week will be based on an educational and fun theme. During each week the children will participate in crafts, physical activities and learning activities all based on the theme of the week. These activities are designed to encourage the development of the entire range of your child's emerging skills: socially, emotionally, physically, academically and artistically. We achieve this through play, imagination and exploration- indoors and outdoors-in both large and small groups.

The goals of our summer program are:

- To help to make learning a year-round experience by providing a program that is both educational and recreational.
- To enable children to experience learning and recreation together in ways that will promote positive self-esteem, socio-emotional learning, and problem solving.
- To offer an excellent educational, recreational, and cultural experience that is consistent with the goals, objectives and mission of Saint Joseph School.

### **Safety:**

No student will be allowed to leave the program until a parent, guardian, or registered pickup person signs the student out with a member of the staff. Parties should be prepared to present photo ID if requested.

### **Discipline:**



**What you will need:**

- Updated health form from your pediatrician (your child cannot attend this program without one)
- Epi-pen/inhaler if needed with a doctor's note (if your child has a medical condition, please disclose on the form below so that we can ascertain if we can support him/her)
- Lunch with an ice pack if perishable
- A morning snack and an EDP snack (if attending)
- Refillable water bottle (labeled with child's name)
- Sunscreen
- Hat
- A change of clothes and underwear
- Small towel, a beach or bath (large) towel, and a tank top/short set (we find that it is difficult for younger students to figure out the ties and bands on swimsuits, so for both boys and girls, pull-on shorts and tank tops are easiest)
- Preschoolers must bring their own rest mat.



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### St. Joseph School Summer Program 2025 Tuition Agreement

The St. Joseph School Summer Program is available to students in preschool through grade 4. All fees are to be paid according to the payment plan specified. **Refunds will not be given for days paid and not attended.**

Our regular hours will be 8:00 am to 2:00 pm. Extended hours will be available until 4:30 pm for an additional charge (our normal EDP fee of \$12/hour). Before school coverage is available at 7:30 am if arranged one week in advance. (Please let us know if you expect to use these services) A fee will be charged for late pickups after 4:30 pm (\$10 for the first five minutes and \$5 for each additional minute.) This fee is payable when your child is picked up or must be paid in full before your child returns for the next session.

Payment must be made by check payable to St. Joseph School (please write "Summer Program" in the memo area).

To guarantee a place for your child in the 2025 St. Joseph School Summer Program, you must:

- Submit registration and contract forms (attached)
- Fill out attendance calendar for June, July and August (attached)
- Turn in payment for all days attending
